	show house to see if they have a copy of the area map. iv) General rights	
	of way/Wiltshire Council ownership of land – WC are querying certain	
	rights of way as to ownership, LTC is under the belief that all rights of way	
	are at the moment WC's. However if this is to be one of the devolved	
	services in that WC will be asking LTC to take on in the future, LTC will	
	need to keep in mind. The committee discussed, no further action needed	
	at this time.
