

# LUDGERSHALL TOWN COUNCIL



Minutes of the Allotment, Cemetery and Car park Committee meeting held on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2013 in the Council Chambers at 7.pm

**Present** Cllrs Giles, Hollis, Cordery, White, Dixon & Dance.

1. **Apologies** for absence, Cllr Pickernell (holiday) and Mr Jarrett (Gardening Club Rep)
2. **Declaration of Interest.** No Declaration of interest received.
3. **Minutes** of the previous meeting had been circulated and approved at the July full council meeting.
4. **Allotments**
  - Bell Street,** New signs will be ordered when the firm is trading at its new premises.
  - Dewey's Lane,** A review of the rules for both sites needs to be carried out due to a complaint about a cockerel on plot number 29. Local and national rules allow up to a maximum of 12 hens, national rules includes a comment "the female of the species", Resolved that those plot holders who have cockerels on their plot will be given until the 31 December to re-home them. Cllrs Giles and White reported that after measurements were taken the actual size of the plot No 34 rented to Mrs Walker is accurate to the map surveyed in 1988.
5. **Budget 2014-2015,** No major projects are planned at this stage.
6. **Jubilee Garden,** Footpath has been treated with weed killer.
7. **Rose Garden –** nothing to report
8. **Car Park,** Works order has been issued to clear weeds and cut back new saplings.
9. **Toilets –** nothing to report.
10. **Cemetery,**
  - (a) New signs will be ordered as in 5 above.
  - (b) An emergency works order has been issued to cut back trailing roses and hedges of the remembrance garden, all work is now complete.
11. **War Memorial,** The invoice for repairs to security lights still not received. Cllr White enquired about a test certificate for the lights this will be investigated and reported at next meeting.

- 12. Ludgershall in bloom**, a list of winners has been published and those concerned have been notified. The trophies can now be engraved and miniatures purchased. The domestic winner will also receive £25 worth of gardening vouchers. Framed certificates will be presented to all seven of those selected as first by the group judges, those selected as 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive laminated certificates.
- 13. AOB**, Cllr White reported that plug plants for the war memorial/rose garden have been received and bulbs will be purchased in due course. Cllr Cordery asked about replacement watering can for the cemetery it is considered by the committee that any new cans will go missing as the previous ones have.
