Minutes of the Civic Events meeting held on 8th June 2021 at the Church Hall, Ludgershall at 7pm.

AGENDA ITEM

008-21/22 1. Apologies – Cllr P Burgon - The Committee resolved to accept these and record under the LGA 1972 Section 99 and Sch 12 para 40.

009-21/22 2. To Receive Declaration of Interests

All Members of the Town Council are reminded to declare any pecuniary or non-pecuniary interests they may have in any business of the Council, its Committees or Sub-Committees, in accordance with the latest approved Code of Conduct. None were declared.

010-21/22 3. Gardens in Bloom – this event is going ahead as planned and the Chair is in talks with the judge.

011-21/22 4. Summer Fete – 28th August 2021 - The Committee agreed £15 per stall. The date had been previously suggested as Sat 28th August, but they proposed to change it to Sunday 29th August from 1-4pm. The Clerk confirmed that the Toilets still need to be ordered and the TENS licence needs to be applied for. The Chair confirmed that a lot of local businesses are interested in taking a stall to promote/advertise their services. The name of the Fete has still not been decided, but this will be agreed asap so the advertising material can be prepared along with the raffle tickets. The Clerk asked the Chair to talk about the proposed fete at the next FTC and she will email all Cllrs to ask for their availability on that date, so specific jobs can be issued to those available. All the usual stalls are planned and it is hoped that the Rock Choir can attend, but it depends on the Government Rules that apply at that time. The Clerk will speak to the Chair outside of the meeting about the forms and spreadsheets. Cllr CA Allan will be in touch with the police, fire brigade and the Bobby Van and the Clerk remembered that the Dog Warden had also asked to attend the next Fete – so they need to be notified.

012-21/22 5. Santa Sleigh – A solid metal sleigh has been found for £4500 that is 2.4m long; Cllr B Dance to forward the quote to the Clerk. 2 x wooden hardwood sleighs have been sourced at a cost of £1650 or £1750 each (these will also be forwarded to the Clerk) and the Committee discussed whether or not wooden ones would suffice. The Committee have earmarked funds of £2500 available, but maybe they could ask the Council for more funds towards it as a Metal sleigh would last longer. A suggestion would be that LTC could let it out for a fee, to other organisations.

013-21/22: 6. Agenda Points for next meeting – the Clerk has been asked if LTC can put on a music afternoon/evening in the Rec. The Committee discussed briefly and agree it is a great idea. Maybe an afternoon event could be held this year and maybe a larger one next year if successful. This will go on to the next agenda.
