CEMETERY RULES

1. Graves

- Basestone 36 inches by 18 inches. Plinth to be safely within the measurements of the basestone. Total memorial height including headstone tablet not exceeding 43 inches. Memorials to be supplied by a member of the National Association of Stonemasons. Following health & safety tests on Memorials <u>All</u> subsequent costs relating to repairs will be borne by next of kin.
- Vase(s) to be incorporated in the base of Headstone.
- One vase/urn per grave will be allowed instead of a Headstone. This must be placed at the head of the grave with the name of deceased engraved on it.
- After a period of 6-12 months allowing for ground settlement <u>ALL</u> graves will be leveled for ground maintenance purposes.
- Kerbing, planting or ornamentation around individual graves will NOT be allowed.
- The Town Council must approve photographs or Pictures to be included on Headstones and dimensions must NOT exceed: height 3 ½ inches, width 3 inches.
- Any emblem/logo to be included on Headstone must be supported by written copyright permission and be approved by the Town Council.

2. Memorials in Garden of Remembrance

- A flat memorial wedge/desktop must not exceed 18 inches x 12 inches (landscape) x 6 inches high. Memorials to be supplied by a member of the National Association of Stonemasons. Following health and safety tests on memorials ALL subsequent costs relating to repairs will be borne by next of kin.
- Vase to be incorporated in the memorial stone.
- Ornamentation or planting on individual plots will NOT be allowed.
- 3. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and any dog waste must be removed.
- 4. All rubbish and waste must be placed in litterbin provided.
